A man of two countries, Parisian-born Michel David-Weill has resided in the United States from 1957-1965, then from 1977 until today. He is an internationally renowned investment banker who has served as Chairman and President of Lazard, LLC, from 1977–2005 and is currently Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Eurezeo and Honorary Vice President of the Danone Group, located in Paris.

Known not only for his business acumen, Michel David-Weill is highly regarded for his discreet philanthropy to innumerable foundations and private projects all over the world. He continues to be a supporter of The American Hospital of Paris Foundation serving as a Director for over 35 years. In addition, he also sits on the Board of Governors of New York-Presbyterian and serves as a Trustee of the Metropolitan Museum of Art. He is also a Member of the "Institut" (Académie des Beaux-Arts) and was President of the "Conseil Artistique des Musées Nationaux" in Paris, for 19 years.

He holds the Grand-Croix in the Order of the Légion d'Honneur, the highest degree in this decoration and is an author of his autobiography "L'esprit en fête" (A Taste for Happiness).



The Hospital believes that the exchange of ideas and practices between medical professionals at the American Hospital of Paris with those in the United States leads to superior medical care. This is why, for over 20 years, the Hospital has actively engaged in organizing medical exchanges with our American partners, including NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital, Weill Cornell Medicine and Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons. We are proud that proceeds from tonight's gala will support this priority project.

This year has been pivotal for the medical exchange program. Thanks to The Florence Gould Foundation, The Starr Foundation and donors like you, the Hospital signed a tripartite agreement with Columbia University Irving Medical Center and Université Paris Descartes to work together on joint symposiums, faculty exchange and research.

Numerous doctors, nurses, medical students and administrators from both sides of the Atlantic met with their colleagues abroad to learn more about current treatments, techniques, strategies and standards. Joint research projects, specifically in breast oncology, are advancing, and in June, the first annual Harvey Cushing Symposium welcomed over 200 healthcare professionals to the American Hospital of Paris. This Franco-American medical conference invited world-renowned specialists to discuss artificial intelligence and medical imaging, and in the next three years, the program will focus on innovative treatments of cancer and reproductive medicine.

As we look to the future of our medical exchange program, the American Hospital of Paris will increase the number of participants and create pioneering new programs, such as an American physician-in-residence position based at the Hospital.

We remain committed to providing the best care and patient experience possible. Our standards are high, and the medical exchange program helps provide our team with the tools to meet them.




This vision requires that the Hospital:
